

DEVELOPMENT OF LAND AND PROPERTIES IN HIGH LITTLETON 1793 TO 1839

After the 1793 survey of High Littleton and 1802 survey of Hallatrow, both of which were updated in 1825, the next surviving Parish survey was the one made in 1838/9 in connection with the Tithe Commutation. A different sequence of reference numbers was used in the Tithe survey to the earlier parish surveys and in order than one can trace individual properties more easily, the following schedules provide a cross reference of the numbers. In addition, a complete remeasure was carried out for the Tithe survey, whereas no remeasure was carried out in 1825.

By comparing the surveys at three different dates one can follow the merging of closes of land and the grubbing out of hedges and the expansion of house building at a time when the population was increasing rapidly as a result of the growth in employment opportunities in the coal mines. Similarly one can compare the type of cultivation of land.
