

INLAND REVENUE VALUATION of 1910.

The nationwide valuation carried out in 1910 on behalf of the Inland Revenue was every bit as valuable as the Tithe Survey carried out in the 1830s and 1840s but less widely recognised.

As at 6th April 1910 the names of occupiers and owners of all the various parcels of land and houses were recorded, together with a mass of other information relative to the valuation of such property. Each property holding was referenced to a marked up copy of the 2nd edition of the 25 inches to the mile Ordnance Survey map.

The Book in which the High Littleton and Hallatrow Valuations appear can be found at Somerset Record Office under reference DD/IR W45/4. Unfortunately not all the marked up maps for Somerset survive at Taunton and the ones relating to the main parts of High Littleton and Hallatrow are amongst those that are missing. However, duplicate copies may be found in the National Archives at Kew.

For the purposes of the Valuation, forms were distributed to all the property owners. The person responsible for the distribution and collection of the forms for High Littleton, on behalf of the Land Valuation Officer, was Henry POLLETT, a stone mason from Temple Cloud, who was chairman of High Littleton Parish Council from 1904/5 to 1921/2. It is probable that POLLETT also created the original entries in the Valuation Book, using as a starting point details from the Poor Rate Assessments. One assumes that these were kept up to date, although the extent of the properties was probably based on the detailed surveys carried out as long ago as 1793 (High Littleton) and 1802 (Hallatrow). Although parish surveys were carried out for Poor Rate purposes after these dates, the respective valuers had been instructed to accept the old measurements as being correct, update the names of owners and occupiers etc. and deal with such areas of land as had been divided up or consolidated.

The area of High Littleton and Hallatrow according to the 1793/1802 surveys was 1,257 acres and this figure was shown as the acreage of the parish in editions of Kelly's Directory up to 1866. Despite the fact that the Tithe Survey was carried out in 1839, when the parish was remeasured, it was not until 1872 that Morris' and later Kelly's Directory showed the 1839 figure of 1,273 acres (which included 25 acres of river and roads, not included in the earlier surveys). This figure remained until 1910, from which date Kelly's reported the acreage of High Littleton parish as 1,303. The Ordnance Survey map recorded a more exact measurement of 1302.596 acres.

The Valuation Book purports to show the historic measurements used for Rate purposes, as well as the new areas as determined by the Valuer, although reality is somewhat different. Only the figures taken from the Poor Rate (Columns 7 to 9) were totalled and summarised and although these contained several addition errors they were nevertheless fairly close to the then accepted area of the parish. The new measurements (Columns 11 to 14) were not totalled at all and, whilst certain items have no figures against them, this is sometimes explained by two or more items being grouped together. Even so, it is obvious that many of the larger land holdings have no new measurements shown against them and by adding up the Valuer's figures one arrives at a total of less than 650 acres. Possibly the Valuer intended to accept the measurements from the Poor Rates in some cases and only recorded those that were different. In the event the Book fails to show what the overall extent of High Littleton parish was.

Most parts of the Valuation are easy to understand. However, there are several instances where information has been added or updated at another time, using a pencil or different pen. It is not clear whether this was done over the days the Valuation was being prepared or in succeeding years. In some cases the full postal address of some Owners' residences have been added after the schedule was prepared originally, presumably when it was decided to post certain forms rather than deliver them by hand. Thus one may find High Littleton, nr Bristol, - Kingwell, Bath, - Milton Damerell, Brandis Corner.

After the High Littleton section of the Book are a number of items with incomplete details, which look as though they may be queries or items thought to have been omitted previously. These cover several parishes but it is possible to identify some that relate to High Littleton and Hallatrow. These "late additions" seem to have been generally ignored in the Valuation. It seems most likely that this Book was a draft or working copy and that the version at the National Archives may be more complete.

In 1911 the population of High Littleton was 1,008. Almost a quarter of the total are listed in the Index of Occupiers at the end of this section. If one takes into account wives and children, the proportion of representation is very much higher.
